Release Notes – August 2, 2010

Summary – Club Bulletin Notifications


Club members can now be automatically sent an email when a Club Bulletin is uploaded to the bulletin file area. This is similar to the capability that was introduced for Committees several months ago.

If the Club elects, any bulletin or file that is uploaded will generate a short email to all Members that have not elected to Opt-Out indicating a bulletin was uploaded.

New Features / Changes

- 1) **Notify on File Upload.** Any member with edit permission (usually Level-4+) can set the notification flag in the club record. This can be found under the Information Tab in the club options section as shown below.

Club Options:

 Notify on File Upload: Notify Club members when a document is added or updated

You can tell if this setting is on when you click on the club bulletin and you are taken to the club bulletin file listing as shown below. If "Notify Members on Upload" is Yes, an email will be sent out when a new bulletin is added to the system.
