- ◆ We're optimistic that with this year's Duck Raffle and Wine & Blues we'll be in great financial shape.
- ◆ We have \$34000 in the bank and \$40000 in gaming (with \$10000 spoken for for scholarships).
- ◆ We've done well letting the gaming commission know of our community hours to allow more flexibility in how we spend the gaming money. We claimed 591 hours at \$20/h for about \$12000 in contributions.
