- ◆ The first time you go to dacdb.com you will log in with your Club Runner username and password **BUT instead of logging in you go to Forgot Password and use it to reset your password**. After resetting the password you can then enter the site.

- ◆ PMail can send email to club members, it will also send you a copy to the email you have on record so make sure your email on file is the correct one.
- ◆ Both Club and District calendars are available. For example, I used the district calendar to find the next DACdb training session on June 22nd and it's Zoom link is in the description.
- ◆ Although we went through many other parts of DACdb you will only learn by signing up and exploring the system. If you have any problems getting access there are many in the club that can help you, including myself. It's pretty easy to navigate once you're in.
- ◆ Mary and Greg have done an incredible job changing over clubs in District 5020 and from what I've seen it's easier than Club Runner. Thanks to both of you!
