### Pioneer Human Services: A Story of Second Chances

Pioneer Human Services is one of the nation's largest nonprofit social-enterprise business organizations. Pioneer successfully operates several revenue-generating businesses, including an aerospace manufacturing company in Seattle.

Meeting customer needs, Pioneer raises funds for its social mission - to assist individuals with criminal histories to lead healthy and productive lives.

Pioneer employs approximately 1,000 employees in over 50 locations throughout Washington, with more than \$90 million in revenues, and serves approximately 10,000 people annually through its jail diversion, behavioral health treatment, housing, and job training programs.

Sixty-nine percent of its enterprise workforce has a conviction history and/or is in recovery from a substance use disorder. Roadmap to Success, its recidivism reduction program steers 98% of its participants towards crime-free lives.
