Challenges Amid COVID-19

Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board Chief, Justin Nordhorn, will share a PowerPoint presentation on the challenges of Liquor and Marijuana law enforcement/ tax collection, followed by Q & A.



The Chief has 25 years of law enforcement experience, He began working at the Board in 1998, and was appointed Chief in 2011. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Law and Justice and graduated from the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command. Along with managing 149 commissioned law enforcement officers and 32 non-commissioned staff, he is responsible for operations of liquor, marijuana, tobacco, and vapor products enforcement, including statewide enforcement policy development. In 2017 he received the Governor's Award for Leadership in Management. Chief Nordhorn is actively involved in labor relations, rulemaking, and legislation. He speaks on the topics of cannabis legalization and alcohol regulation and enforcement to national and international audiences. He served as president of the National Liquor Law Enforcement Association .2017-2018.
