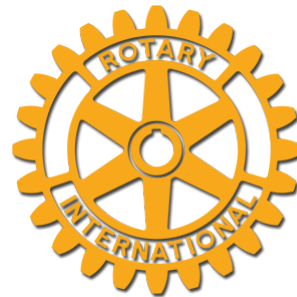

## TODAY'S PROGRAM

Today's program was introduced by MARIE PRICE. Colby Matilla, director of KTEC, has lived in North Idaho his whole life. He has a BA in Technology Education and a MA in Education Leadership, both from the University of Idaho. He was hired by KTEC in 2013, and in 2016 was appointed as director.

Kootenai Education Technical Campus, located on the Rathdrum Prairie, is a tuition free campus, owned by three local school districts (Lakeland, Post Falls, Coeur d'Alene) and works closely with area industries. This hands-on school provides students with technical skills to allow them to be successful in the community, industry and society.

Many of KTEC's programs are dual credit with North Idaho College. Programs include Construction Trades, Health Professions (medical assistant, CNA), Automotive Technology Program (ASE

certification), Diesel Technology (ASE certification), Automated Manufacturing (CNC & Machining), Computer Repair & IT Networking, Welding & Metal Fabrication, Media Graphics, Millwright, Resort Academy for Hospitality Services, Auto Collision & Repair, and HVAC.

Students spend half of the day at the KTEC campus. They attend school at their regular high school for either the morning or afternoon shift. In 2020 there were 366 students enrolled and this year 466 students. Male to female student population depends on which program students are involved with. There was a 98.9% placement rate for last school year's students, while most years it is a 100% placement rate. Most nursing students are going on to post-secondary schooling to earn a bachelor's level degree. Welding & fabricators and other program students are coming out of school going straight into industry with solid jobs. Employers come present at KTEC throughout the year and begin recruiting students before they have even graduated!
