Wednesday, November 4, 2020

Larry Rhodes, Eugene Airport Rotary, has been working on Rotary projects in and leading Rotary groups to Uganda for 15 years.

Our November 6, 7 a.m., program will share a Rotary project to bring maternal and child health care (one of the Rotary areas of focus) to rural communities of Tororo, Uganda. On a typical day in Uganda, sixteen women will die giving birth, most without the benefit of ante-natal and birthing services. Now, facing the looming threat of the pandemic's spread to Africa, the maternal and child health care project is urgent--and Rotary can and will act!

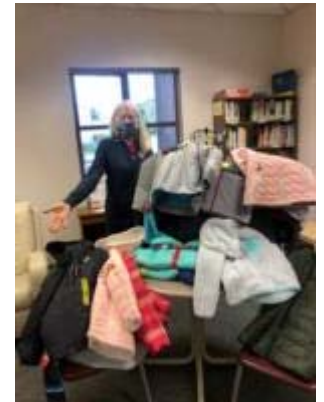
