

Are you ready? We re getting together for a happy hour gathering with some of our former members. We re looking forward to seeing them  on Zoom  and hearing what they ve been up to.



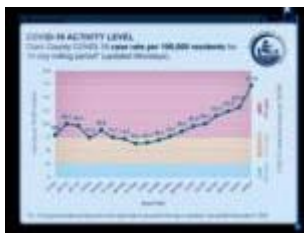
