Rotary in Africa

As you may know, Vancouver Sunrise Rotary is pursuing two district grants to support projects in Uganda: repair of wells, and setting up medical clinics as part of a rural maternal/infant health pilot program. I am planning to go on the next trip there, in late January or February.

You can come, too. Here's the word on that:

We are announcing the opportunity for club members to participate in teams that will be going to Uganda in January. The Vancouver Sunrise Club has been involved with an important international Water & Sanitation project to repair broken well pumps and pipes restoring water to 32 communities serving many thousands of people. The teams will have opportunities to see first hand the impact of this and other Rotary projects. One of the two teams will include medical doctors, nurses, and support staff to provide medical assistance to communities without doctors.

We will assemble in Entebbe/Kampala on January 29. We recommend you stay for two weeks, but can

accommodate an earlier return if necessary. The cost on-the-ground for food, lodging, and transit runs about \$800 a week; you arrange your own air travel. The group is coordinated by Larry Rhodes (larryrhodes@gmail.com) of the Rotary Club of Eugene Airport. Larry has led teams to Uganda for the past fourteen years. Please let him or PP Jerry Rhodes know your interest and you will be invited to planning meetings before any further commitment is needed.
