at the District Celebration in Seaside, Oregon

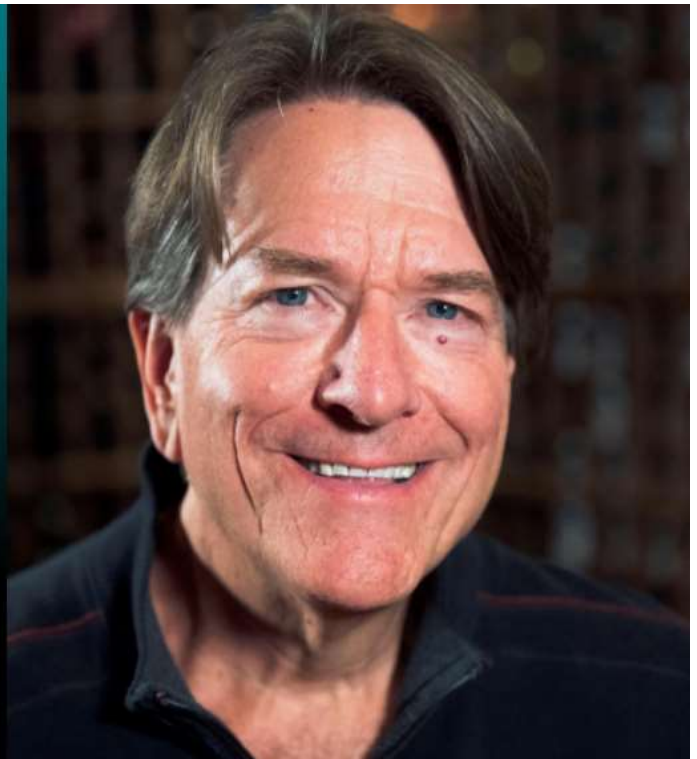

Jim Bernau originally started representing the Oregon Wine Advisory Board in 1981 with the passage of the Oregon Wine Advisory Board. The purpose of the Board is for research and promotion of the industry. Simultaneously he began searching for vineyard land and found an old overgrown pioneer plum orchard in the Salem Hills. In 1983 He began planting Pinot Noir Vines. Jeff's wines have appeared on TV shows like West Wing and Friend along with White House State Dinners. He founded Willamette Valley Vineyards and was listed among the top 100 wines in the world by Wine Spectator Magazine. Willamette Valley Vineyards has grown to more than 19,000 wine enthusiast shareholders and is listed on the NASDAQ under the symbol WVVI and WVIP.

Jim also updated us on the Lake Oswego Restaurant that is scheduled to open in the 1st Quarter of 2022. The restaurant will be located off State Street and Highway 43 in Oswego Village adjacent to Whole Foods. The location will feature outdoor patio space with a firepit and over 3,500 square feet of interior space. The menu will consist of Northwest cuisine with wine lockers, retail wine purchases and a private wine cellar dining room. They will also be opening restaurants in Vancouver, Happy Valley and Bend.
