Our Featured Speaker!

District Attorney John Wentworth

*“How Adverse Childhood Experiences
Impact Future Behavior “*

Our guest speaker was John Wentworth, District Attorney for Clackamas County who is a career prosecutor with 26 years of experience as a trial attorney where he developed a reputation for being tough but fair. John has successfully prosecuted some of Clackamas County’s most dangerous offenders — murderers, rapists, domestic violence offenders and child abusers, and is recognized statewide as an expert in domestic violence, sexual assault, and elder abuse. He has also successfully led efforts for tougher laws for the protection of Oregon’s elders and domestic violence victims.

John is focused on promoting public safety through fair and equal justice and brings solutions to complex issues using data-driven and common-sense approaches. He focusses on ACE’s (Adverse Childhood Experiences) and how this impacts future behavior and creates some predictability. In short, John addresses the root causes of crime.

John also serves Clackamas County as a member of the Board of Directors at Parrott Creek Child and Family Services, and as a board member of the Children's Center, an accredited child abuse intervention center. He received his Bachelor of Science degrees from Oregon State University and his Juris Doctorate from Lewis and Clark’s Northwestern School of Law. He also works with nonprofit organizations like Parrott Creek www.pcreek.org and Camp Hope www.camphope-wa.org
