From Conversation to Action



Contrary to popular believe, LOSD has a diverse student population. Anecdotal data shows that a large percentage of students of color don't feel like they have a positive educational experience in the district.

In recent years, we have had incidents of bullying and harassment against students who are members of historically marginalized groups. Student outcome data shows that there is still an achievement gap between white students and students from underserved populations. Lake Oswego school district developed the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Advisory Committee (DEIAC). *April, 2018 and the School Board adopted an Equity. June, 2019.*

### District Actions Include:

- Tracking incidents of hate speech and discriminatory acts
- Extanto Curriculum Analysis
- Curriculum Adoption Equity Checklist
- Funded multicultural and diverse literature to be added to school libraries to provide opportunities for students to experience windows and mirrors.
- Restorative Justice and Practices-Diana , Coaching Peace Framework (CRT, SEL-Character Strong, Trauma Informed Teaching, Restorative Practices)
- Affinity group
- Equity Audit
- Anti-Racism Board Resolution
