President, Van's Aircraft Kit Planes

Van's Aircraft Kit Planes were founded in 1972. It is the world leader in kit aircraft design, manufacturing and sales.

Almost 11,000 kits have been completed and flown, averaging 1.3 new aircraft flown every day.



In 2020, Van's will sell over 2,000 airplane kits. 30% of sales are to international customers. They utilize state of the art CAD design and CAM manufacturing.

Van's provide pilots, who have basic mechanical skills, the ability to build their own aircraft. And, even though you still have to build it yourself, they make it easy to afford and build.

Early kits took a lot of work and patience. In the 90's they introduced quick build kits - saving hundreds of hours of owner build time. It used to take from 1600 to 1800 hours of work – the newer quick build kits knock off a 3rd of that time.

They offer 2 seaters and 4 seaters with various configurations. New kits are developed regularly, including a new model launching next year.

Based in Aurora, Oregon, they employ 93 people at the main facility with representation in the mid-west and east coast. Many employees have worked there for 20 and 30 years.

The Library building is still closed to the public, but is offering many virtual programs and events.

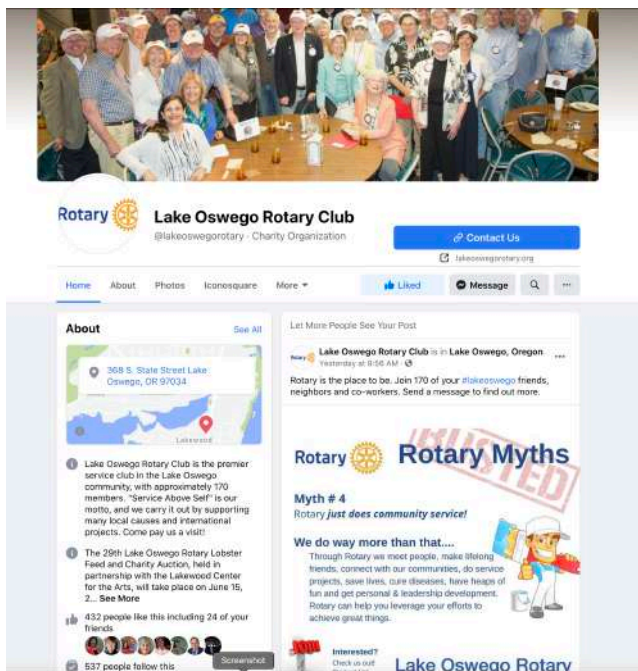
