“The Mindset of a Champion is not something you are born with. It is forged and sharpened through hours of thoughtful practice.” Matthew “Mat” Fraser (born 25 January 1990) ~ An American professional CrossFit athlete known for winning the 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020 CrossFit Games after taking second place at the 2014 and 2015 CrossFit Games. After a strong performance in 2014, and the retirement of 4-time defending champion Rich Froning Jr., he was a favorite to win in 2015, but was edged out in the final event by Ben Smith. The following year, Fraser took first place by a commanding margin, and Smith took second. Fraser is the first person to win five consecutive CrossFit Games titles. Mat has a background in Olympic weightlifting. He is the son of Canadian Olympic figure skaters Don Fraser and Candace Jones.

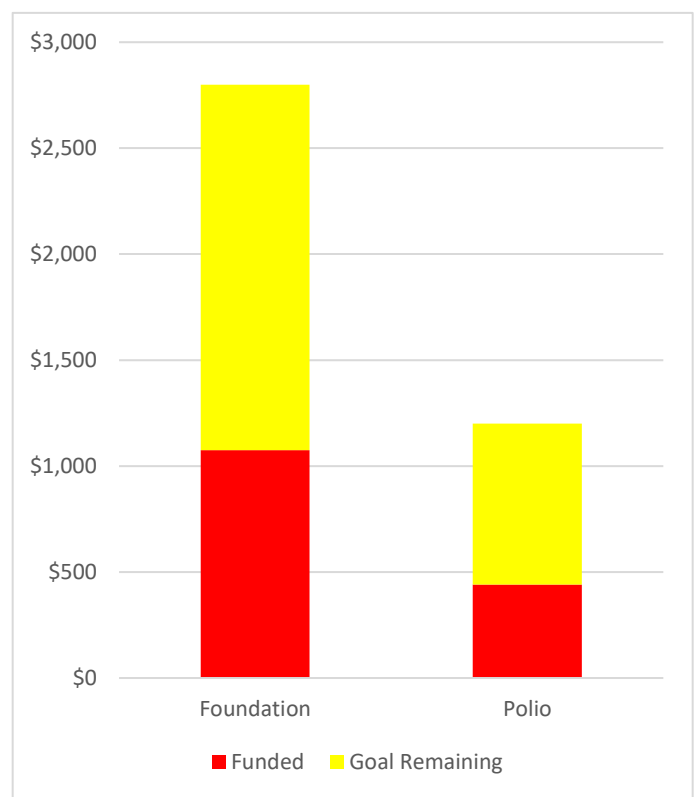

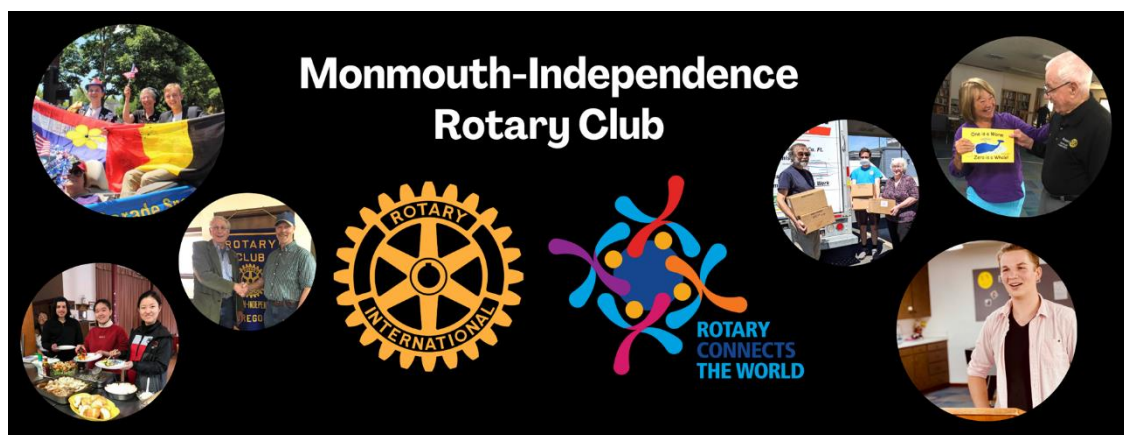
