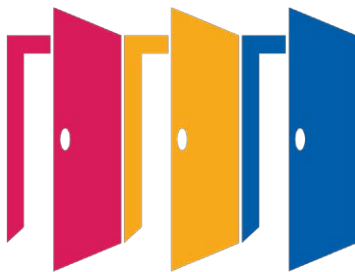

We always need volunteers. So, any way you can help is great.

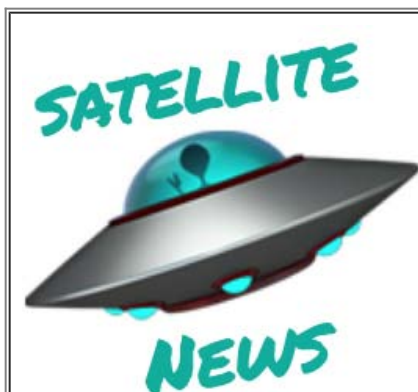
