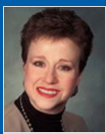

FROM THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR!

Dear Nicole,

Carisa Hettich, Rotarian with the Eugene Delta Club and Director of SW Oregon American Red Cross, is requesting your help. She especially needs help in the Talent/Medford/Phoenix/Ashland area. She is heading there today with her Red Cross Team. Counties affected in our District include: Douglas, Jackson, Josephine, Klamath, and Lane.

Rotarians can volunteer by registering as volunteers on the American Red Cross website. After you register, you will be vetted and complete an online background check. Also required is about 3 hours of online training including a couple of videos on COVID safety. Volunteer assignments could be in-person logistical assignments for shelters or virtual online assignments doing such things as locating food and getting meals delivered to shelters.

During COVID the Red Cross is working to find hotel rooms for the displaced. Second choice is "congregate shelters" like schools and churches. Shelter volunteers are needed to help with
