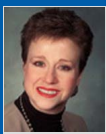

Peace Literacy expert and West Point graduate, Paul Chappell to share tools for Peace Building in Turbulent Times.

Paul Chappell, director of the Peace Literacy Institute headquartered in Los Angeles, CA, believes peace education and activism needs to be taught in the same way that we teach soldiers to wage war and students to learn reading and mathematics.

The Iraq War Veteran and West Point graduate will offer a peace literacy conversation on Sept. 17 that will provide  new frameworks for understanding complex conflicts , said Chappell, referencing recent peace protests in Portland, OR. Chappell s Zoom event will be held on Thursday, Sept. 17, from 7 to 8:30 p.m. The public event is sponsored by Rotary International District 5110, which involves 66 clubs and 3,200 Rotarians in central and southwestern Oregon and northern California.

Peace Literacy,  he said,  can offer people new skills for navigating conflicts in ways that move communities and the world toward greater peace and justice.
