LEMON LINGUINI

1 lb. linguini

1/2 c. olive oil

zest from 1 lemon (more?)

juice from 2 lemons or more

1/2 c. chopped green onion

1/4 c. chopped fresh parsley

salt and freshly ground pepper

LOTS of Parmesan cheese

Cook linguini in boiling salted water till done, drain well.

Combine next 5 ingredients in a large serving bowl. Add pasta and toss well.

Sprinkle over salt and pepper.

Toss in Parmesan to taste.

Optional: May toss in another ingredient of choice.
