The enormous Hynix chip factory in Eugene, vacant for a dozen years, could spring back to life next year building video display technology for its new owner, an Ohio company called Stratacache.

Stratacache expects to start a pilot line in Eugene by summer of 2021, with more than 100 workers slowing ramping up production. The privately held company hopes to begin full manufacturing, with several hundred employees, sometime the following year.
