An Oregon Overview

This program will address Oregon woman-suffrage activism, including national context and with specific information about Black women's activism, the significance of Native sovereignty, and the impact of xenophobia and citizenship on women's voting rights.

Eliza E. Canty-Jones is Editor of the *Oregon Historical Quarterly* and Director of Community Engagement at the Oregon Historical Society. Eliza was co-founder and served as President of the Oregon Women's History Consortium, which created the statewide centennial project, Century of Action: Oregon Women Vote, 1912 (2012).

White supremacy has been a central part of Oregon's history since before the state's founding, but Black, Indigenous, and other women of color have nevertheless provided leadership in the fights for full citizenship, including voting rights. From direct action at the ballot box in 1872 to a campaign to remove racist language from the state constitution in 2002, Black women in Oregon have taken bold actions to dismantle structures of oppression. This presentation will offer broad context for understanding Oregon's racist history as well as specific stories of the ways Black, Indigenous, and women of color have worked to envision and create an alternate future.


