

Michael Morter with the state's Office of Emergency Management is presenting a snapshot of Oregon's 2020 Wildfires: Response/Recovery/Rebuilding.

As the state's Wildfire Recovery Ombudsman, Michael's primary responsibility is working with state and local agencies to identify and resolve issues in the built environment--planning, zoning, wetlands, floodplain, and building codes among others. Although assigned to the Office of Emergency Management, he reports directly to Matt Garrett, Director for Wildfire Recovery in Governor Brown's office.

Rotary Day at Last Mass Vaccination Covid Clinic.

Over the past 3 months we helped vaccinate 135,000 of our neighbors by volunteering almost 4,000 hours at the mass vaccination clinics. Lane County Public Health is now transitioning from the large clinics to smaller clinics weekdays to reach a variety of residents who need to be vaccinated.
