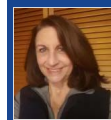

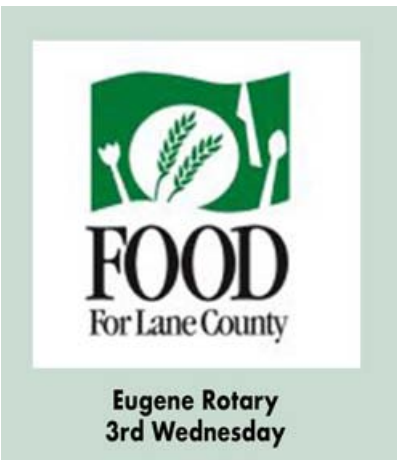

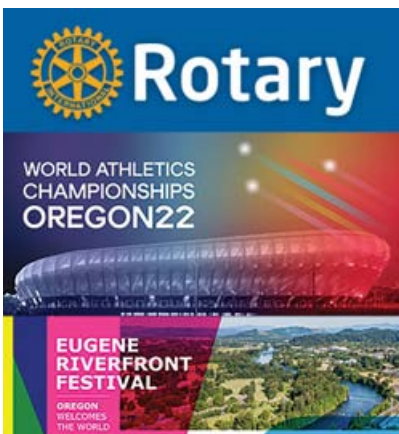
## The Rotary Foundation (TRF) Message

## World Championship Booth

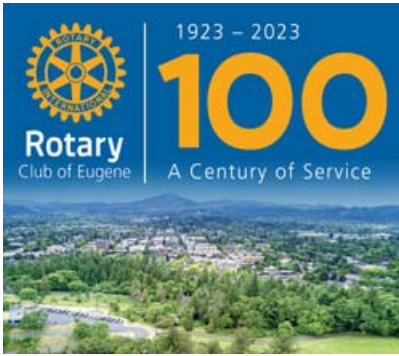
