Annual Skinner Butte Work Party – Covid Variant!



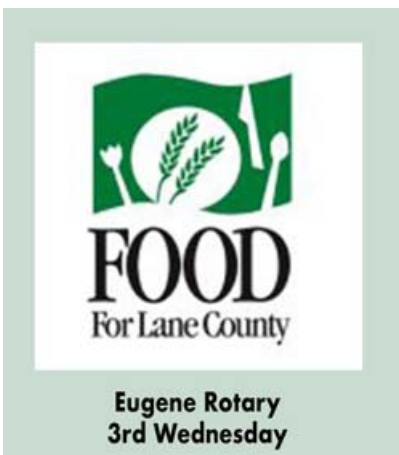

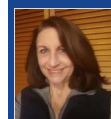

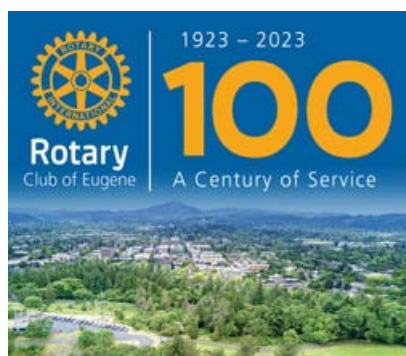
