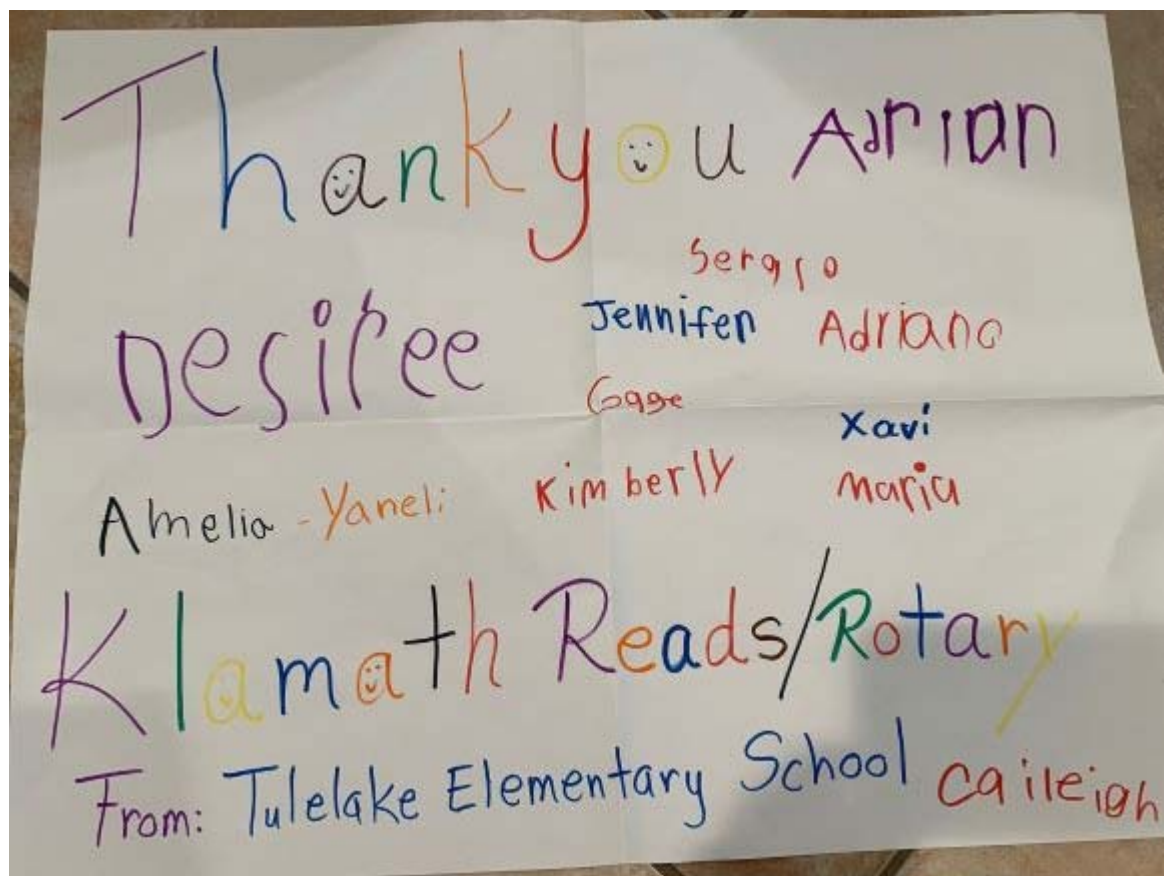
The July 9th, 16th and 23 Rotary meetings will be held in the Ross Ragland theater lobby due to the youth drama summer camp in the Ragland Events center.
