Years of Service

October 24th was World Polio Day where Rotary and the Global Polio Eradication Initiative group celebrates the great accomplishments made since Rotary launched the Polio Plus campaign in 1985. Glen's great program last week brought home the need to continue Rotary's fight to end polio. Our Rotary Board pledged to donate \$1500 and use our Club Foundation Recognition Points to match all member donations. Glen also agreed to match the first \$500 of donations. So far, the membership has pledged over \$2000 additional donations making our gift to Polio Plus over \$4000 and 2500 Club Foundation Recognition Points towards the donors Paul Harris Fellow. Beyond that, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation will match all donations 2 to 1, making our \$4000 gift now \$12,000. Great work...

DA Davidson long term account: On October 12th, the Board meant and discussed 15 potential projects for the use of this \$60,000 that languished in an account since at least 1999. At this time, two projects were funded.

1. A donation to the Fort Klamath Military Post park in Fort Klamath to build 8 story boards about the Military Post.
