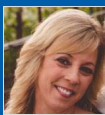

## Today's Announcements

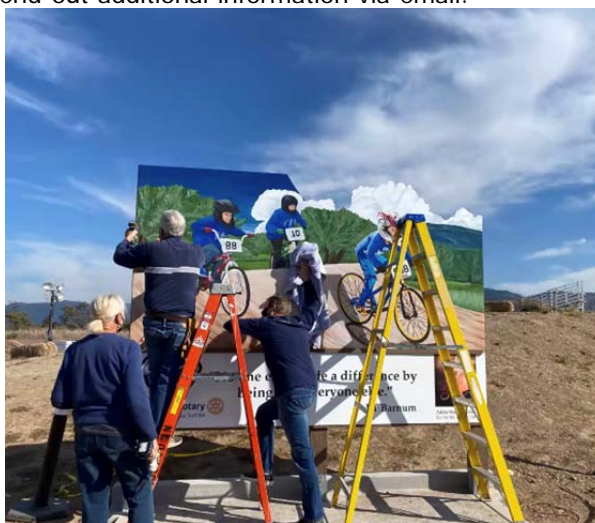
