In 2008, she was appointed to the Oregon state Governor's Council on Ending Homelessness where she served for three years. Cindy has a breadth of experience that spans street level outreach, developing homeless services systems, and driving public policy change at both the regional and state level.



With the world being far from normal even for our great friends of the community, The Living Room, have adjusted do what they do best serve our community. During the COVID 19 Pandemic they have handed out everything you can image to those in need: Food, cloths, tents, back backs, diapers, hand sanitizer and first aid kits just to name a few. They have reconfigured their offices to house more families, set up supplies to help the wounded and as always become a resource center to connect those who need with those who help. All this while losing 50% of their staff. At peak of crisis they were serving 2 hot (to go) meals to 180 people a day. They have changed their way of doing business from women and children to helping anyone who needs food. They found peace and comfort in the Rotary Garden for staff and guest. So, we can all follow their lead and remember to take care of those around us and sometime to change the way we do thing to help the most people.
