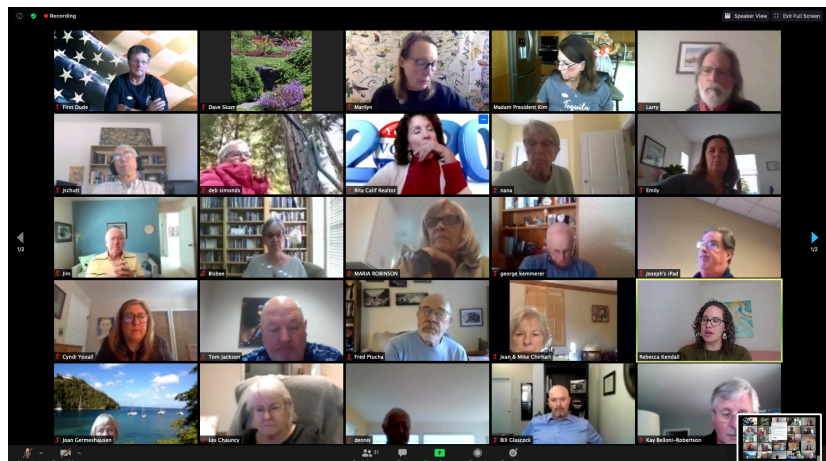

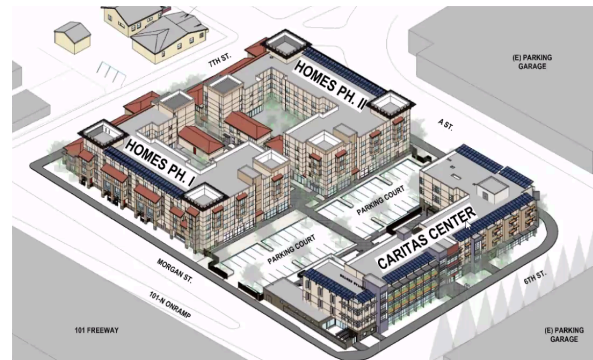
Our speaker was Rebecca Kendall of Catholic Charities. She gave a presentation about their latest project, Caritas Village. A joint venture with Burbank Housing.
