Voting 2020 and Fire Assessments With Marie Proto

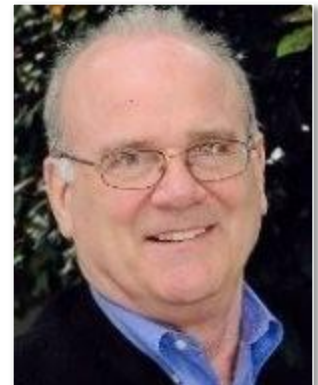
