District 5150 District Governor 2021-22 Danielle Lallement recently visited the Rotary Club of Redwood City and outlined her vision for the upcoming Rotary year.

Danielle manages an ICU in San Francisco that has been heavily involved with the COVID-19 Pandemic. She told her very personal story of caring for the sick and dying while trying to manage the location set-up (e.g. "the contractors were finishing the doors as our 1st patients were wheeled in...") to dealing with the isolation of patients from their families (e.g. "we have an iPad on wheels that is used to communicate with family).

She reminded us that as members of Rotary we are part of the care community and have shown great compassion for our community during the pandemic with the Redwood City Feeding Our Hero's Program where Rotary was one of the largest contributors to the program.
