Tasha Johnson is the Youth Services Network Manager for the City of Antioch since 2019. Tasha Johnson has been working in the education and social services field for over 20 years with an emphasizing social justice. She began honing her communication skills while working in politics, but soon discovered that her calling was educating youth in Washington DC.

Tasha moved to Los Angeles and began working for youTHink, a social justice arts organization that fosters critical thinking, engages diverse learners, promotes literacy, and serves as a tool for social change serving in the capacity of School Services Manager in Los Angeles Unified School District.

In her next position, Director of Youth Services for the Greater Sacramento Urban League, she established and created programs that supported youth and young adults who came from vulnerable populations.


resolution and trained in cross-cultural facilitation techniques.


# Delta Force Rotarians Serving on District 5160 Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Committee
