## This Week's Speaker, Tasha Johnson

Thursday, July 29, 2021



Tasha Johnson is the Youth Services Network Manager for the City of Antioch since 2019. Tasha Johnson has been working in the education and social services field for over 20 years with an emphasis on social justice. She began honing her communication skills while working in politics, but soon discovered that her calling was educating youth in Washington DC.

Tasha moved to Los Angeles and began working for youTHink, a social justice arts organization that fosters critical thinking, engages diverse learners, promotes literacy, and serves as a tool for social change serving in the capacity of School Services Manager in Los Angeles Unified School District.

In her next position, Director of Youth Services for the Greater Sacramento Urban League, she established and created programs that supported youth and young adults who came from vulnerable populations.

She is a three-time presenter at the California Association of Teachers of English on critical pedagogy and incorporating a social justice lens into curriculum, served on the steering committee for the CREWS program through the Southern California College Access Network, developed and facilitated professional developments for Loyola Marymount University, California Conference for Equality and Justice (CCEJ) certified facilitator in conflict resolution and trained in cross-cultural facilitation techniques.
