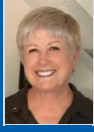
Important Club Announcements:

-Volunteer Help Needed October 3rd To Help Paint The Antioch Historical Society Gazebo.

We could really use your help. Invite a family member or potential member to our Club!

-The Antioch Rotary Club's Day of Golf, a social spaced activity, has been planned for October 16, 2020. This event allows everyone the enjoyment of playing golf with your friends and community members in a safe environment while helping the Antioch Rotary Club fundraise for the community. Our event has built into our "Day of Golf" all of the social distancing practices utilized by Lone Tree Golf and Event Center - Starting times for each foursome going off in 9 minute intervals starting at 7:30 AM (sunrise is 7:18 that day), one person per cart, etc. We can book starting times up to 1:30 PM. We will be serving a lunch after golf for each of the groups utilizing Lone Tree's beautiful Patio Dining area where you can watch competing groups coming up #18 and cheer them on. Each group will have about an hour and a half or so in the dining area to eat, drink and be merry! Since individual carts will be utilized our rounds are expected to be 3 hours and 30 minutes and you have a choice of formats - Scramble or Cha- Cha for those that would like to play their own ball. We will need volunteers at check-in from 7 AM to 1:30 PM. If you would like to help, please let Milanka know at milanka13@msn.com. Each Rotarian is expected to sell \$125 in raffle tickets. We will not be separating the tickets by 3 different prize packages; instead, we will pool all the raffle tickets in one big pool with 10 prizes. The top prizes will be 1) Spending Spree 2) Sports Package 3) TV (thank you to Dr. Bob for the sponsorship of this prize) and the rest of the prizes (4 - 10) are to be determined. We would like each prize to be a minimum of \$200 with the spending spree prize around \$2,000. As far as tickets, we will not be using the ones that were passed out to you previously. Instead you will be given a series of numbers for your tickets to sell. We will need everyone help with raffle prizes. You can also choose to donate a monetary amount such as \$50 directly to Antioch Rotary Club for the purpose of purchasing gift cards or raffle prizes on your behalf. Winners will be selected via random number generation. Raffle prizes will be dropped off the day after the tournament (if you would like to make raffle prizes deliveries, please let Milanka know at milanka13@msn.com.) Because of covid-19, you can make payment or donations to the club three ways: via credit card (call Graeme at 925-382-5521, check (mail to our P.O. Box 692, Antioch, CA 94509) or by Zelle (via your bank/app). Entry fee for golfers is \$140.00 per golfer (includes: range balls, green fee/cart, tee prize & lunch). Besides golfers, we need sponsors for this event. 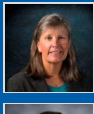

[Debbie Toth, CEO of Choice In Aging](#) - October 1st
Choice In Aging

OUR SPEAKER THIS WEEK: Our Speaker this week is Choice in Aging speaking on how to age independently with dignity especially during the COVID environment, Thursday, 10/1/2020 @ 12pm PST via Zoom.

Debbie has spent over 25 years working in the service of elders: a population she fell in love with in high school while working at the Motion Picture and Television Fund's Country House their independent living housing.

Debbie joined the Choice in Aging team as the Mt. Diablo Center for Adult Day Health Care program director in 2002 and has been growing the organization since through bringing on additional types of aging service programs that support community living with independence and dignity. She became the agency's CEO in 2012 and helped the agency expand from one county to four counties and worked with the Board of Directors to bring an intergenerational preschool into their array of programs and services. Choice in Aging now provides adult day health care, intergenerational Montessori preschool, community-based care management, mental health services for older adults, transitions out of skilled nursing facilities, transportation, caregiver support, policy advocacy and more!

Debbie is a tireless advocate for elders and their dignity and has served locally on a variety of business, transportation and health boards as well as having served on the state's Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Advisory Committee since 2013 and was most recently appointed to the Governor's Master Plan for Aging Stakeholder Advisory Committee. Her dream is to build an Aging in Place Campus that has independent housing with all of the wrap around services Choice in Aging

provides and prove you can have dignity, a high quality of life and independence for less money than living in skilled facilities. The plan is well underway!

Michael Whalen has over 15 years experience directing and supervising health care and activity programs for vulnerable populations, including children, adults, and seniors. Mr. Whalen ran two large day programs for adults with disabilities in New York City, where he was responsible for the care and services of up to 70 clients with developmental disabilities. From 2013 to 2015 Mr. Whalen was Day Services Manager for Easter Seals Bay Area, directing the daily and long term operations of a child care center with over 40 children and young adults with disabilities. Since 2015 Mr. Whalen has been the Program Director for Choice in Aging's Mt. Diablo Center for Adult Day Health Care. In August 2018, Mr. Whalen switched roles in the organization to become the new Program Director at The Bedford Center.
