Each class is receiving \$300 from our club that will be earmarked for literacy; giving each teacher the ability to buy extra books for their classrooms.

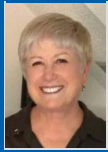

These schools need our help: Kimball (55 students), Turner (64 students) and Fremont Elementary (62 students) for a number of projects. They have Samantha Liposko, our youth director has been in contact with Principals Christie Steiner, Sylvia Ramirez and Deborah Meylan to make these programs happen.

Here's some statistics about these schools:

- 181 Third Graders
- All Students are on Free or Reduced Lunch
- 30% or more are English as Second Language Learners
- 84% or more are Socioeconomically Disadvantaged

**World Polio Day Proclamation at Antioch City Council Meeting on
October 12**

At the October 12th Antioch City Council, Mayor Lamar Thorpe declared a proclamation to recognize October 24th as World Polio Day. Assistant Governor Milanka Schneiderman thanked the mayor for his proclamation.

This year, World Polio Day is observed on October 24. This annual observance was established by Rotary

International in order to commemorate the birth of Jonas Salk, the developer of a vaccine against polio. ... Salk's inactivated vaccine and Albert Bruce Sabin's oral vaccine helped save thousands of children.

The annual number of wild poliovirus cases has declined by more than 99.9% worldwide from an estimated 350,000 in 1988 when the Global Polio Eradication Initiative was launched. Of the three serotypes of wild poliovirus, type 2 was certified as eradicated in 2015 and type 3 was certified as eradicated in 2018.
