The DVLS is a non-profit program to mentor people who are learning english. The students are primarily adult immigrants and the mentoring is done one-on-one, on a regular basis, in year-long assignments.

Lucy told us that in Contra Costa 10% of people cannot effectively speak english, almost 70,000 adults are not fluent and she

estimated there are about 292,000 immigrants in our county.

Learning english is key to finding a better job.

Most publicly funded English as Second Language (ESL) programs have waiting lists. The DVLC has been providing their services for over 40 years. Their program is more flexible than classroom programs as mentors and students set up their own meetings and customize the lessons to the needs of the students.




DVLC is staffed by volunteers - no paid staff.


**Ron Mullin** celebrated his wife Cathie s birthday with \$20 to the club.

PDG **Tina Akins** offered a closing thought by Victoria Holt - If it s good it s wonderful, if it s bad it s experience."






