Theresa Hurley, Executive Director of the Contra Costa Bar Association, spoke about the Bar. One third of their members are sixty years old or more. Sixty-five percent of all law practices are composed of a solo individual or less than three members.

The Bar Association provides many services. They provide education for all twenty disciplines of the Bar. The general public may request legal referrals, including regular, reduced fee and pro bono assistance.

If they recommend a law firm, they get a percent of the fee. They work with local law students. Additionally, they have a committee that recommends lawyers to the governor for licensure.
