The DOAR is part of the Performing Arts Guild at Rossmoor (PAGR), a designated group of fourteen associated clubs. The PAGR is composed of many groups including the Ashmolean singers and many others related to the arts. PAGR has performed before more than 16,000 people in Rossmoor. They offer 112 performances per year. Their most recent productions were "Our Town", "Broadway Bound", and "Our Two Cents", to name a few. Hank defined many famous Broadway statements such as "break a leg", which refers to being able to bow after a performance due to its success. He educated us about the world of drama.
