#### **PROGRAM**

Today's speaker was Fred Kern from the Ad Hoc Rossmoor Technology Planning Committee. His

background is extensive in global technology and



electrical engineering. The committee is composed of seven community members working on twenty-five projects to make Rossmoor more sustainable. The major areas are landscape, fire abatement, traffic issues, architecture, and disaster

assessment. He told us the following:

## Technology:

- Our fiberoptic backbone is 22 years old and needs upgrading, adding 144 strand cable enhancement.
- The data site will be moved to Creekside for a generator and fuel. .
- GRF tv/internet services are being considered.
- The use of autonomous vehicles is being explored here. We are we are still in the development stage.
- Business intelligence and room reservations are being enhanced over internet.
- Wi-Fi coverage will replace wired system for all public areas.
- Web-enabled member interactions will be considered.
- Core IT system will be upgraded.

## **Traffic Issues:**

- Transportation subsidized by GRF will use Uber/Lyft starting in October.
- More LED lights for the streets will be added.
- Solar sites for common areas, possibly above parking areas will cover 100% of Rossmoor's needs.

## Landscaping/Fire abatement:

Irrigation technology upgrades for use during next drought.
