Dianne Wilson is a Rotary member who is very involved in helping the youth in Sierra Leone. That charity started with a donation of an RV and subsequent matching donations. Since then, the charity has focused on the following:

- Over 4,000 people have died of sepsis due to waste. Therefore, cleanliness and sepsis control is a top priority. With the deadly Ebola virus it is needed even more so. In spite of all they do, Ebola may be coming back.
- 2. They established an orphanage and school there. Their focus is to help the orphans in the village to have clothes, backpacks, food, education and other aspects of life. It costs \$1,400 per year to care for each child.
