Tom limited his talk to digital resources, which he says are very user friendly. If confused just drop in and they will help. One needs to obtain a library card to open this magic door to so many services. LinkedIn Learning has over 60,000 articles. With Kanopy you can check out eight video titles a month. Also available are The Great Books Courses, Flipster for magazines, Rosetta Stone for learning foreign languages, and Overdrive is for eBooks. You can check out materials for 7, 14, or21 days. There are over 36,000 titles. Libby is an app for checking out e-books and audio books for your tablet or phone. Patrons are allowed to have 6 titles checked out and 10 on hold. When we are back open there are lockers in Rossmoor/Gateway where you can pick up and return library materials. There were lots of questions.
