<u>Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance:</u> Joy Alaidarous, Skip led patriotic song "God Bless America"



<u>Guest Speaker-</u> District Governor, Mark Roberts. This is the DG's **annua**l visit providing updates on District 5160's activities to date. Everything about 2020 has been colored by the Covid-19 pandemic. All clubs in the District since the State imposed restrictions on congregate gatherings are now meeting **virtually**.

Zoom has been his friend. Mark expressed gratitude for clubs' innovative actions to **stay connected**. This is certainly a better way than conference calls. In talking about the ongoing concerns about **membership**, Mark emphasized that to bring in new members and retain members, we must keep in mind that "our club members are our customers." Recognizing our members is a fundamental priority.

Mark talked about Rotary's new focus on **supporting** environmental causes.

He talked about how the variety of new clubs that are being formed, i.e., "passport (travel) clubs; corporate clubs; cultural, social and ethnic clubs.
