PROGRAM

Jan Pinkerton-Spieth is the President of the Mt. Diablo Beekeepers Association (MDBA), one of the largest hobbyist beekeeping associations in California. Jan was hooked on honeybees starting in 2006, when a swarm of bees flew into a wine barrel in her backyard. Prior to becoming president, she served as VP, Community Education and was responsible for planning and implementing honeybee education programs and community outreach in MDBA's threecounty service area. Jan still finds time to teach honeybee classes in the schools and presents educational programs to community groups, garden clubs, etc. Jan grew up in Berkeley, received her degrees (AB, MPH) from UC Berkeley and has been a Lafayette resident since 1990.





Jan gave a wonderful presentation that was chock full of the history of beekeeping, the influence of

honeybees on the almond industry here in Californiathe U.S. produces 80% of the world almond consumption; it's the 7th largest food export; over 1.3 million acres of almonds are grown in California over 500 plus miles; and all of the U.S. crop is grown in California. 10% of all water use in California is for almonds.

This presentation touched on the history of beekeeping, including types of hives, ancient and modern. The seasonal life inside the hive is explored, including the role and lifecycle of the queen, her workers and drones; foraging for pollen, nectar and water; environmental and parasitic pressures that are making honeybees sick and the impact on California's almond agribusiness that produces 3 billion pounds of almonds on 1.26 million acres and contributes 7 billion dollars annually to the economy.
