PROGRAM

Speaker was Carol Weed, a retired Kaiser physician who now heads the Sustainable Rossmoor group. She was talking to us about recycling. If we mess up what we put in our containers our mutuals can be fined \$28 to \$58 per incident. So, it behooves us to get it right. Don't put big plastic trash bags in the recycle bin, dump them out. No lids in recycle. Next November there will be measure on the ballot regarding plastic pollution, vote YES. To dispose of fluorescent bulbs take them to Ace Hardware on Mt. Diablo in a container in aisle 9. Rapid Recycle will take electronics. Paint if almost empty let it dry out and then put it in the landfill container. Most paint stores will accept fuller paint cans. Aerosol cans spray until all aerosol is gone then put in the landfill container.
