New placemats were in use for the first time and look great!


PROGRAM

Rev. Mark Burnham was discussing micro-homes and that the church is working on getting six micro homes built on the church grounds along with a laundry facility to assist homeless persons. This will increase security on the property. The church is partnering with a number of organizations including Hope Solutions, Walnut Creek Homeless Task Force, and Presbytery of the San Francisco Area. They have been having some NIMBY response, but overall, the community has been supportive, and the rent will be about 20% of the rent of an apartment and will be offered on a sliding scale.
