## This Week's Presenter

### Mt. Everest

Larry Seaton

**Larry Seaton** has spent 45 years in the construction industry in a variety of top project management positions. He has built schools, shopping centers, offices, estate homes and even a jet fighter base for the Israeli Air Force. He now lives in Napa Valley and primarily works as a construction consultant for wineries. In 2010 at the age of 59, he began alpine mountaineering and ended up climbing five of the world's Seven Summits. In April 2015, he was part of a team attempting to summit Mt. Everest when a devastating earthquake hit Nepal, killing 15 climbers. That expedition was the subject of the book: [Shook: An Earthquake, a Legendary Mountain Guide, and Everest's Deadliest Day](#). Larry will review his eleven years of mountaineering experience, including what happened on Mt. Everest, and show us some of his climbing equipment.
