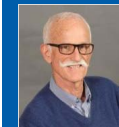

Phil Wilke introduced Dave Schlom for our program. Dave was a science teacher in Corning and has had a radio program on NSPR called Blue Dot and an expert on the Apollo missions in the early 1970s. These missions are celebrating their 50 year anniversaries with Apollo 15 launched on July 26, 1971. Where the Apollo 11's purpose was simply to go and safely come back, this 4th mission was to do science collections and included the first use of the Lunar Rover. Details he shared: There are 18,000 foot mountains on the moon, the rover ran on 3 26volt batteries and had 4 wheel steering, the astronauts lived on the moon for three days.
