Announcements

- Geralyn shared a presentation from Aloha Rotary. The 2020 Rotary Virtual Convention was virtual June. <https://convention.rotary.org>.
- At the BOD meeting, the budget was approved.
 - Time for Kids, and continued projects for literacy.
 - Approved \$11k in misc local projects.
 - Projecting 30% less revenue due to the crisis.
 - We currently have \$96k in our checking and \$31k in the recovery fund.
 - Next meeting 20th of August after our regular meeting.

 - We have a \$10k grant and \$8k in our portion for a total of \$18k for the park.

Programs

Carl O introduced Jessica Starkey who has works with the Boys and Girls Club. At the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic the club started teaching the kids about germs (with glitter) in early march, added extra wash stations, then closed down as required. They then pivoted to delivering meals to the community and created vitural programming and zoom case management.

With California opening up, they reopened slowly, working with Butte County and requiring training via zoom, face masks, temperature checks and extensive hand washing. They also switched to home room style environment with one leader per a group of kids all day and limiting the moving around the building. Contact sports are no longer available but baseball is still played.

She shared they are preparing to go back to shelter in place and if so they will expand the zoom case management and zoom tutoring. In any case, they are hoping to reopen during the school year to support the after school activities. The program was followed by an extended Q&A session.
