They recently worked on a project for boring under Highway 99 for sewer piping. This involves creating a bore pit and then a bore hole. The work is very intensive. The work under 99 was drilling through hard pan and cobble. Different types of soil present different challenges. The engineering for this type of work can take years before a project comes to fruition. Although boring is very expensive, it usually is cheaper than disrupting existing roadways.
