District 5160 Annual Conference

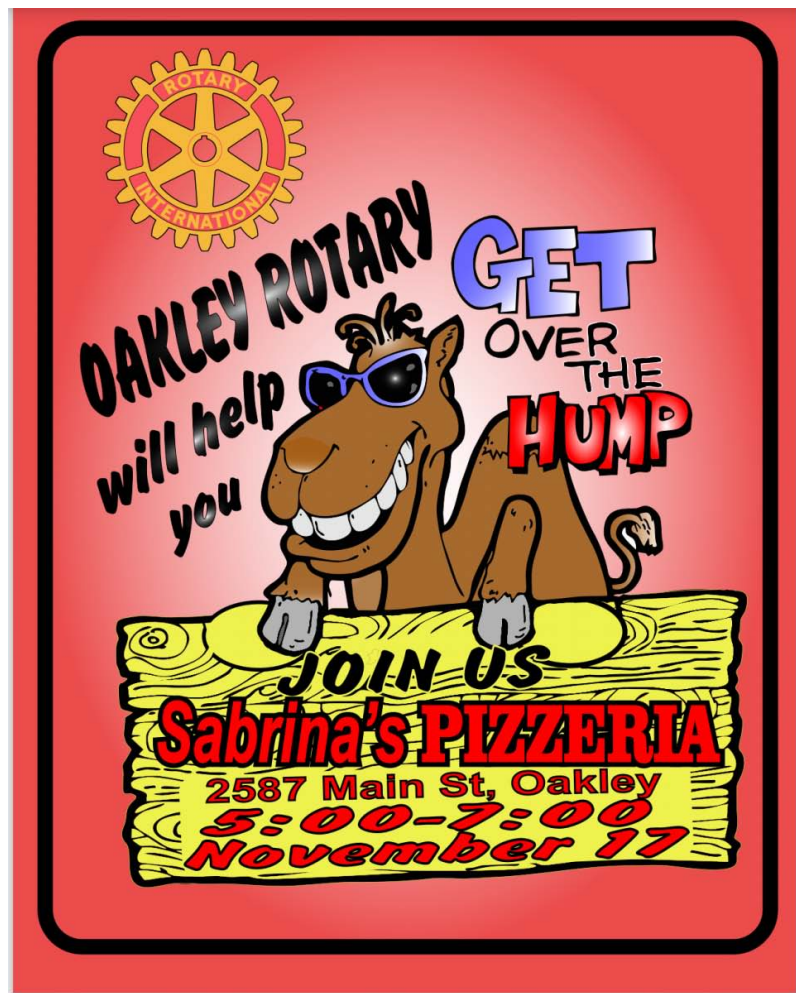
