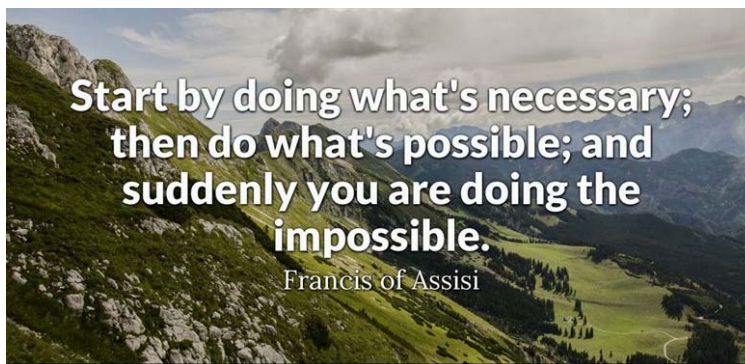

The event is part of Oakley Science Week, one of the city's signature annual events, drawing tremendous community support for animal encounters, hands-on discoveries and outdoor exploration.

The unique week-long celebration of all things science, draws about 75 to 100 local elementary school students.
